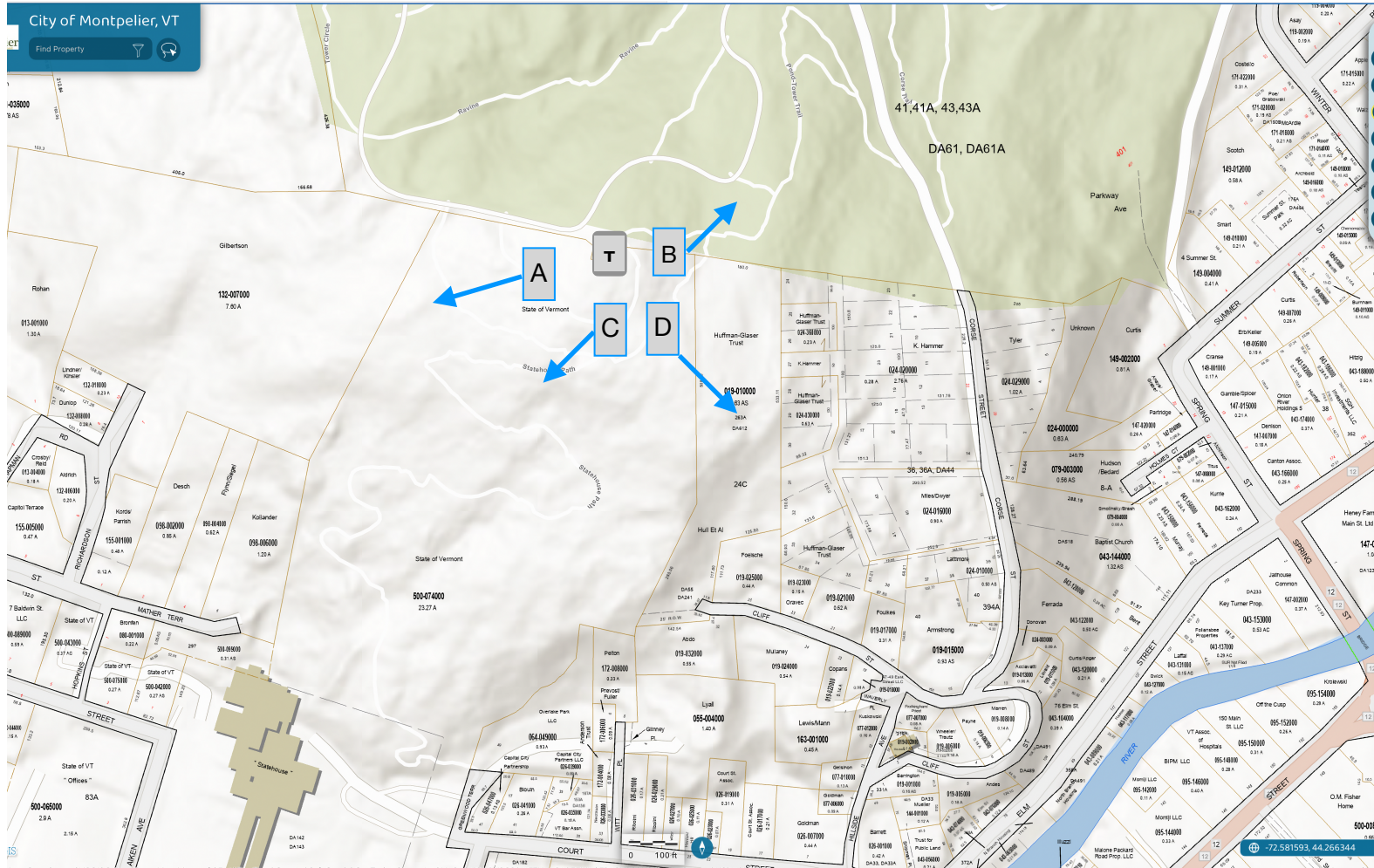


# Hubbard Park Views



**T = Tower**

View A - to West possibly towards Camel's Hump

View B - to Northeast possibly towards Hunger Mountain

View C - to Southwest possibly towards Berlin hills and National Life

View D - to Southeast possibly over town

A - The land with trees to remove is partly State of VT with Eric Gilbertson's lot behind it. There are red pines that could be taken out, possibly on Eric's land. Current view shows Green Mountains with some identifiable peaks like Killington & Pico.

B - The land with trees to remove is in the Park near the gravel road going down to the road. A quick look at the trees pointed to the possibility that 10 or so trees could improve the view and the lumber could be used to build things for the park

C = The land with trees to remove is mostly State of VT where the big softwoods section along the statehouse path probably needs to be taken out since they are in danger of falling in wind storms. Replanting trees could concentrate on lower growing things like apples or berries - an edible landscape.

D - The land with trees to remove is some Park land but mostly private small empty lots owned by individuals or associations. It would make a nice view of the city but is complicated in terms of permission to remove trees.

Comments:

The group liked the idea of concentrating on a few specific views to be improved.
